

## The fake democracy of the failed state Belgium

Even in the most recent elections of 2019, the number of seats achieved in the Belgian federal parliament is disproportionate to the number of votes obtained. It has been known for a long time that small parties are disadvantaged against large parties. But there is much more going on. Let's look at some results.

The French-speaking PS won 641,623 votes for the Federal Chamber of Representatives and received 20 seats for this. Vlaams Belang received 810,177 votes for the same room but only 18 seats. Converted Vlaams Belang gets 168,554 votes more than the Walloon PS, but still gets 2 seats less in the Chamber of Representatives.

But there's more. There is also a clear difference between the Flemish party Green and the French-speaking party Ecolo with almost the same program. Ecolo received 416,452 votes. Green received 413,538 votes. The difference is barely 2,614 votes. M.a.w. in number of votes there is very little difference between Ecolo and the Flemish Groen, but Ecolo gets no less than 13 room seats, while green gets only 8, a difference of 5.

Ecolo was the big winner on the French-speaking side. The Flemish Sp.a was in the losing camp. But Sp.a did receive 455,034 votes, or 38,582 votes more than Ecolo, which received 416,452. But in reality, the Flemish Sp.a gets 9 seats, and therefore four Chamber seats less than the French-speaking Ecolo who gets 13. A difference of 4.

We also compare the Flemish CD&V and the French-speaking PS: the CD&V received 602,520 votes, or 39,106 votes less than the PS with 641,623 votes. But converted to seats: the PS gets 20 seats and the CD&V gets only 12 seats. A difference of 8.

The only distribution of seats that is proportional to the number of votes obtained concerns the Christian Democrats. The French-speaking CDH obtains 5 seats with 250,861 votes and the Flemish CD&V with 12 seats 602,520 votes. Seat distribution can therefore also be fair, just and normal, although this is a single exception.

But it only becomes hallucinatory if one compares the largest parties from above and below the language border. The French-speaking PS, largest party in French-speaking Belgium, obtained 20 seats with 641,623 votes. The largest party in Flanders, the N-VA with 1,086,787 votes only 25 seats. With a fair and even distribution, N-VA would have to get 3 seats more and the PS 3 seats less. In the defense, that is 6 seats out of 150 distributed unjustly.

All regime-true political scientists and left-wing professors hurried to report that everything is "normal" and that there are logical explanations. It will. But it remains a simple observation that in the Chamber of Representatives, the French-speakers are getting abnormally more seats than they would receive in a proportional distribution. And it is in the Chamber of Representatives where joint matters are decided.

If one counts all valid votes cast on the French-speaking and Dutch-speaking side, one finds, taking into account the votes on parties that did not obtain any seat, that French-speaking parties were awarded 16 seats in 150 too many and Dutch-speaking parties 14 seats in 150 too little .

If one only takes into account the votes for parties that did get seats, it is established that French-speaking parties got 12 seats in 150 too much and the Dutch-speaking parties 12 seats in 150 too little. The vote of every Flemish voter is therefore in fact worth 8 percent less than that of a French-speaking voter! Totally undemocratic and in no way admissible.

Moreover, the French speakers have an undemocratic veto right under a constitution that blocks the Flemish majority and discriminate all Flemish people. And then Louis Tobback, Miet Smet, Willy Claes, Eric Van Rompuy, Guy Verhofstadt and Karel De Gucht (older politicians from the traditional Belgian parties) dare to come on the state channel and in the main stream newspapers to talk about "racists," "fascists" and sympathizers of Adolf Hitler and his National Socialists .

Add to this the scandalous fact that from the saved earnings of every taxpaying Fleming, for decades, an average of around 1,500 euros annually continues to flow to French-speaking Belgium, and that through an open frontier mismanagement, a horde of fortune seekers and Mohammedan invaders receive from the Belgian government pout of the wallet of every Flemish taxpayer a living wage and an increased child allowance as a result of polygamous family reunification, then it is understood that the slander talk of the politicians inculcated by the citizens is many steps too far.
